

# Invite the Heidelberg Project to your school!

## Here's how it works.

A representative of the Heidelberg Project will introduce children to the wonderful world of the Heidelberg Project through a fun, visually stimulating presentation that consists of:

1. A Reading of a book called *The Big Orange Splot* by D. Manus Pinkwater. In this book, Mr. Plumbean decided to change his community (10mins)
2. An introduction to the real Mr. Plumbean (Tyree Guyton). A film presentation of *Come Unto Me, the Faces of Tyree Guyton*, a 30 minute award winning documentary about the history of the Heidelberg Project ( Parents Choice Award in 2004).
3. Next we move to a wonderful discussion about Tyree Guyton's vision to transform his community into a street of dreams. Our goal is to inspire children to develop their own creative ideas and to assist teachers in incorporating creativity in the Classroom. (30 mins.)
4. Each school will receive a Heidelberg Project educational kit which consist of:
  - a. A copy of our film for your library
  - b. A children's guide to the HP
  - c. A list of suggested reading
  - d. A Connect the Dots poster to hang in your school.
  - e. A Heidelberg Project PowerPoint presentation
  - f. A age specific Heidelberg Project arts activity
5. Finally we invite schools to create their own (Heidelberg inspired) dream house, photograph it and send it to us and we will add to our "just for kids" web page.

- The total presentation time is about one hour and fifteen minutes for up to 100 students at a time.
- The fee is just \$300
- An auditorium or Gym setting is preferred
